

Communal Worship

Weekly Liturgies

Each girl participates in one liturgy (service) each week. The liturgies provide a regular time of reflection and are an act of communal worship for all girls. These liturgies, with the input of the girls and staff, include a number of interactive styles of worship based on a scripture reading chosen for the day. Drama, dance, classical and modern music, and communal actions all play their part in the liturgies. The girls are encouraged to participate fully and to give regular feedback to ensure the liturgies remain engaging and prayerful.

Morning Prayer

Each tutor group is encouraged to pray together at the start of each day. Prayer resources are produced by the girls or the Chaplaincy to help provide structure and a communal aspect to these times of prayer.

Evening Prayer

During Lent and Advent, evening prayer takes place at 5:30 in Chapel and takes a different form each day of the week. Each boarding house also holds evening prayer each evening using their own prayer book produced by the Chaplaincy.
